- 2.5 minimum grade point average
- School and community involvement
- Letter of recommendation from the Criminal Justice Department
- Full time class standing
- Personal/telephonic interview

Please have the student email the scholarship packet to include an official transcript, application, essay, proof of student full-time status, and letter of recommendation combined to crigibsonscholarship@gmail.com. Each letter of recommendation must be on official letterhead and include name, phone number, and email address.
